for Scotland's communities

HOW DOES IT WORK?

The world around us is changing at an unprecedented rate, offering new challenges and opportunities for everyone working for social change in Scotland.

In order to thrive in this ever-changing world, people and organisations are realising that they need to collaborate, learn from each other and take time to develop the right kind of behaviours, mind-sets and skills. Learning and Development has therefore never been more important.

While we believe that everyone working for social change should have access to high quality learning and development, this is not always affordable or accessible for community groups and organisations.

What is the Strategic Partnership Fund?

The Strategic Partnership Fund was established by The Scottish Government in collaboration with the Social Enterprise Academy to make learning and development more affordable to community groups, membership organisations and social enterprise networks delivering impact across Scotland.

Who is eligible for support from the Strategic Partnership Fund?

- You are an organisation or support agency whose aim is to support third sector organisations and social enterprises e.g. Third Sector Interfaces, Social Enterprise Networks
- Organisations or projects that support local community groups
- Funding organisations seeking learning and development opportunities for your fund recipients
- Community organisations
- Social incubators

How does the Strategic Partnership Fund work?

1

We will meet with you to learn more about your organisation and the learning and development needs of your members, beneficiaries or local community group.

2

Together we will agree what support is required.
We will then design a programme that best suits your learners' needs.

3

We will create a proposal and calculate the total investment required to deliver the programme. You will only be required to invest a proportion (usually half). We will utilise the Strategic Partnership Fund to subsidise the cost, substantially reducing the amount that you or the learners will need to invest.

SOCIAL IMPACT

Through peer support and participative learning, our bespoke programmes support individuals and organisations to become more sustainable and better able to serve their community.

The fund subsidises learning and development programmes that support individuals, community and third sector organisations to be more enterprising in the way they address social and environmental issues. Programmes usually focus on understanding the social enterprise approach, enterprising leadership skills, community leadership and starting or developing your social enterprise.

Enterprising Leadership

4 - 6 days

This programme explores some of the skills, mind-sets and behaviours required to lead in an enterprising and innovative way, ensuring organisations can address different challenges and seize new opportunities. It will enhance learners' understanding of what it means to be enterprising and how this approach can support them to achieve their organisations vision, mission and values.

Leadership in the Community

4 - 6 days

This programme aims to help build confidence in local people so they recognise they can be community leaders. It gives the learners a greater understanding of what is meant by leadership and an opportunity to reflect upon themselves as leaders. The programme is designed to build a strong support network amongst learners who can identify together how they can become potential change agents in their community to help take responsibility for addressing local issues.

Starting and Developing Your Social Enterprise

6 days

This programme will help your community group or members to understand and utilise the social enterprise model. It will help you build practical skills to develop, test, and progress ideas, and explore what it takes to create a sustainable enterprise which supports social change.

Measuring Social Impact

2 days

Every day, Third Sector organisations set out to add value to society and make a difference in the world. Identifying how we do this, articulating and measuring the difference we make and getting buy-in from our organisation to make this a priority can often be a challenge. However at a time of decreased funding and resources, it is vital that third sector organisations are able to prove and show their added social value.
